



Rahul Gandhi Playing into the Hands of Foreign Powers

Congress leader and Leader of the Opposition in the Lok Sabha, Rahul Gandhi, on Wednesday alleged that 2.5 million fraudulent votes were cast in last year's Haryana elections, amounting to 'vote theft'. Rejecting this, the Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) termed the allegations baseless. At a press conference held at the BJP headquarters on Wednesday, Union Minister and BJP leader Kiren Rijiju said that Congress leader Rahul Gandhi is making false and illogical claims to hide his failures. He said that voting is taking place in Bihar in two days, but today Rahul Gandhi was narrating a story about Haryana. This clearly shows that there is no issue left in Bihar, so the Haryana issue is being fabricated to divert attention. Rahul Gandhi is saying that the exit polls showed the Congress winning. During the 2004 elections, the exit polls and opinion polls were also predicting a victory for the BJP and NDA, but the

counting results showed the NDA losing. We accepted the result and congratulated the UPA, but we did not abuse the Election Commission. In a democracy, both victory and defeat have to be accepted. He said that when the exit polls are in favor of the Congress, they applaud them, and when they go against them, they abuse the media. He said that when the elections were underway in Haryana, senior Congress leader Kumari Selja herself had said that the Congress would not be able to win there because its own leaders wanted to defeat the party. After this, a former Congress minister resigned and clearly stated that the Congress lost in Haryana because its leaders were not working at the grassroots level. He asked how the Congress could win when the state president, Rao Narendra Singh, himself admitted that there was no coordination at the grassroots level within the Congress party? Their own leaders are saying that the Congress lost because of its

Rahul Gandhi alleges 2.5 million fake votes stole Congress's victory in Haryana elections, now fears similar conspiracy in Bihar

Congress president and Leader of the Opposition in the Lok Sabha, Rahul Gandhi, held a press conference titled 'H Files' at Indira Bhavan in New Delhi on Wednesday, leveling serious allegations of large-scale vote rigging in the Haryana elections. He also expressed apprehension that what happened in Haryana could now be repeated in Bihar. This press conference took place just before the first phase of polling for 121 assembly seats in Bihar on Thursday. Rahul Gandhi alleged that approximately 2.5 million fake voters were created in Haryana and that it was a case of 'organized vote theft'. He claimed that this fraud was not carried out at a local level, but at a higher level. He said that there are a total of approximately two crore voters in Haryana, of which every eighth voter is fake. Giving figures, he said that 25,41,144 votes



are fake in Haryana. These include 5,21,619 duplicate voters, 93,174 invalid addresses, and 19,26,351 bulk voters. In addition, Form-6 (adding names) and Form-7 (removing names) were also misused on a large scale, but the Election Commission has now blocked access to this data. Rahul Gandhi stated that this matter is extremely serious because despite such massive vote theft, the Congress party lost by a margin of only 22,779 votes. He said that the election results were manipulated in a planned manner. The Congress leader showed a picture of a Brazilian model and claimed that the same photo was used to cast votes 22 times at several

booths in Haryana under different names. He said that this model is registered in the voter list sometimes as 'Seema', sometimes as 'Saraswati', and sometimes as 'Sweetie'. He further stated that the photo of the same woman was repeated 223 times at two booths in Haryana. It is also alleged that a man named Shashank Giri voted 14 times at booths number 431 and 508, while two brothers, Rudrabhishek Jain and Naman Jain, cast 18 votes at booths 130 and 131. Rahul Gandhi stated that the Election Commission could easily identify all the fake voters with similar photos or addresses through a simple process, but it is not doing so. Rahul Gandhi also played a video of Haryana Chief Minister Nayab Singh Saini at the press conference, in which Saini is seen saying before the results were announced that "the BJP is forming a government with a clear majority."

NDA returning to power in Bihar with a two-thirds majority: Rajnath Singh

Defense Minister Rajnath Singh, while addressing an election rally in Banka, Bihar, in support of the National Democratic Alliance (NDA) candidate, claimed that the Nitish Kumar-led NDA is returning to power in the state with a two-thirds majority. He also targeted all the parties included in the Grand Alliance, including the Congress. Targeting the Congress, Rajnath Singh said that the Congress never wanted better roads in the border areas. The Rashtriya Janata Dal (RJD) also did not want development in Bihar. Rajnath Singh attacked Rahul Gandhi for politicizing the army and said that soldiers only follow one religion, which is "military dharma." Do not drag our army into politics. Whenever this country has faced a crisis, our soldiers have held India's head high by displaying their bravery and valor. During his address, he said that reservation should exist. We (BJP) are also supporters of reservation. We have given reservation to the poor. Rajnath Singh said that Prime Minister Narendra Modi has ended the anti-development

mindset in the country's politics. When Modi ji took power, the Indian economy was in 11th place in the world. Today it is in fourth place and will soon reach third place. Rajnath Singh said that not a single allegation of corruption has been leveled against Nitish Kumar to date, while all the leaders of the RJD, from the bottom to the top, are facing corruption cases. He said that during the RJD rule, Bihar's health budget was only Rs 700 crore, which has now increased to Rs 20,000 crore under the NDA government. This is proof of how serious

the government is about the health of the people. He said that today Bihar's budget is more than Rs 3 lakh crore, which is writing a saga of development. Rajnath Singh said that the NDA never discriminates against people on the basis of caste, creed, and religion. We only talk about development, while the Grand Alliance only works to divide people in the name of caste, religion, and language. The Defence Minister said that Operation Sindoor has not been stopped, and if terrorists try to attack India again, we will give a strong response.

228 Passengers Stranded in Ulaanbaatar Brought to Delhi by Air India Flight



New Delhi: 228 passengers stranded in Ulaanbaatar, the capital of Mongolia, were brought to Delhi on Wednesday morning by an Air India flight. These passengers were stranded in the Mongolian capital when their flight from San Francisco to Delhi was diverted to Ulaanbaatar on Monday. The Air India relief flight, a Boeing 787 Dreamliner, carrying the passengers from Ulaanbaatar, arrived in Delhi, the national capital, at around 8:24 am on Wednesday. The relief flight AI183 had departed for Ulaanbaatar on Tuesday afternoon. An Air India spokesperson said that the relief flight carrying the passengers and crew of AI174, who were stranded in Ulaanbaatar (Mongolia) after a precautionary diversion, arrived in Delhi this morning. The spokesperson, on behalf of Air India, thanked the local authorities in Ulaanbaatar, the Indian Embassy in Mongolia, the DGCA, the Government of India, and all those who helped ensure the care of the passengers and crew and their safe return to Delhi. The airline spokesperson also thanked its passengers for their patience and understanding during the diversion. The spokesperson added that the safety and well-being of our guests and employees are our highest priority.

Supreme Court delivers setback to Centre on MNREGA, scheme to resume in Bengal

Just days after facing a setback in the Supreme Court regarding the Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme (MNREGA), the Ministry of Rural Development has decided to consider restarting the scheme in West Bengal under special conditions. The TMC-led government had been continuously appealing to the Centre to restart the scheme, which had been suspended for three years. Now, it may be resumed. Media reports, citing sources, stated that the ministry had informed the PMO last week that it could consider restarting MNREGA in West Bengal under special circumstances. The PMO had sought a detailed report from the ministry on this

issue. This development comes after the Supreme Court dismissed the Centre's special leave petition on October 27.



The Centre had challenged the Calcutta High Court's order of June 18, which directed the implementation of the MNREGA scheme in West Bengal from August 1, 2025. Before the Supreme Court, the High Court had given the central government the authority to impose special conditions, restrictions, and rules for the implementation of the scheme in the state to prevent any irregularities in the future. The Centre had challenged this order and filed a petition in the Supreme Court on July 31, a day before the High Court's order was come into effect.

Six Women Killed After Being Hit by Train in Mirzapur

Mirzapur. A tragic accident occurred on Wednesday morning in Mirzapur, Uttar Pradesh, when several pilgrims were hit by the Kalka Express train, resulting in multiple fatalities. Many others were seriously injured. The railway authorities have confirmed the deaths of six women in the accident. The death toll is feared to rise. Following the incident, there was chaos and panic at the station. According to reports, the train accident took place at around 9:30 AM at Chunar railway station. A passenger train from Chopan had arrived at platform number 3 of Chunar railway station. Due to overcrowding, many pilgrims disembarked not onto the platform but onto the train tracks on the other side. At that moment, the Kalka Express arrived on the adjacent track, and before the passengers could react, several were hit by the train. Approximately six women died in the accident. Body parts of many passengers were scattered along the railway tracks. Railway officials stated that the Kalka Express did not have a scheduled stop at Chunar, and therefore, it was traveling at high speed. Eyewitnesses said the accident happened so quickly that no one had time to react.

No More Arbitrary Pension Cuts Government Takes Big Decision Regarding Central Government Employees and Pensioners

The central government has provided relief to millions of central government employees and pensioners by clarifying that once a pension/family pension has been authorized (finalized), it will not be subject to deductions unless a clear clerical or calculation error is proven. This order has been issued by the Department of Pension and Pensioners' Welfare under the Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances and Pensions. According to the new system, if any error is found in a pension or family pension more than two years after it has been sanctioned, it will be mandatory to obtain approval from the Department of Pension

and Pensioners' Welfare before making any deductions. The department further stated, 'This applies if such an error is found more than two years after the date the pension was fixed or revised. This step is significant because previously, departments often reduced pensions or sent recovery notices citing erroneous calculations, even many years after retirement. This practice will now be stopped. What if excess pension is received due to an error? It has also been clarified that if a pensioner has received an overpayment due to an error, and it was not due to their fault or incorrect information, the concerned ministry will have to decide whether the amount should be recovered or waived.

Train Accident: Parents of the Child Found Alive in the Wreckage Still Untraceable, Death Toll Rises to 11

A horrific train accident occurred in Bilaspur, Chhattisgarh, on Tuesday evening. A passenger train (MEMU) traveling from Gevra Road to Bilaspur collided with a stationary goods train. The death toll in this accident has risen to 11, while 20 passengers were injured. The South East Central Railway has attributed the cause of the accident to a signal overshoot. The injured have been admitted to hospitals in Bilaspur, and rescue operations are underway. Amidst the screams and chaos in the wreckage, a young child's life was saved. The parents of this child, who was injured in the accident, have not yet been traced. When the railway

administration and local people started the relief operation, this innocent child was found injured near the wreckage. He was immediately admitted to the railway hospital, where he is undergoing treatment. The tragic part is that the child's parents have not yet been found. The railway administration has appealed that anyone who has any information about the child's parents or relatives should immediately contact the railway hospital or the Bilaspur railway control

room. The South East Central Railway said that relief and rescue operations were started immediately after the incident. NDRF, Railway Police, local police, and medical teams jointly conducted the operation. All the injured have been admitted to nearby hospitals, where they are undergoing treatment. The railway administration has provided an assistance amount of Rs. 50,000 to all the injured as primary relief. Senior officials are continuously inspecting the hospitals and meeting with the injured to inquire about their well-being. While many families lost everything in this accident, an innocent child survived, but his parents have not yet been traced. A team is treating him at the hospital.

Pakistan in Panic After Operation Sindoor, Monitoring Every Activity Closely

The neighboring country, a haven for terrorists, is constantly apprehensive about what kind of trouble India might unleash next. Since Operation Sindoor, Pakistan has been closely monitoring every Indian military activity. The Indian Army, Navy, and Air Force are conducting joint exercises, which has caused considerable unease in Pakistan, especially within the army. Islamabad is currently reeling from a two-pronged attack. On one hand, the Tehrik-i-Taliban Pakistan (TTP) is continuously carrying out attacks, while on the other hand, Baloch insurgents are inflicting constant blows. The Pakistani army and police have been completely unsuccessful in dealing with this. On the other



hand, India is conducting joint armed exercises from the desert to the sea, which has created panic in the neighboring country. The statement by the Director General of Inter-Services Public Relations (ISPR), Lieutenant General Ahmed Sharif Chaudhry, is a result of this frustration. In light of this, Pakistan is issuing a flurry of NOTAMs (Notice to Airmen). Intelligence and media analysts suggest that internal

pressure and strategic vulnerability are behind this statement. Pakistan is facing challenges such as internal law and order issues, TTP activity, and attacks in Balochistan, making it necessary to project a message of national unity. The ISPR statement is considered a step in this direction. As a sign of security preparedness, Pakistan has issued a NOTAM closing large parts of its southern airspace, along with coastal areas, from November 1st to November 30th. According to analysts, this move may be related to potential sea-based live-fire or missile tests during the Trishul exercise. Pakistan is also facing widespread conflict on its border with Afghanistan.

Plot to destabilize Punjab foiled, cache of weapons including 245 live cartridges recovered

Chandigarh: Acting on the directions of Punjab Chief Minister Bhagwant Singh Mann, the Punjab Police has achieved a major success during its campaign to make Punjab safe and crime-free. Amritsar Rural Police recovered a large cache of weapons and ammunition from Gonhewal village (on the banks of the Ravi River) near the Indo-Pak border. The recovered weapons include two AK series assault rifles, eight magazines, one .30 bore pistol, two magazines, 50 live cartridges of .30 bore and 245 live cartridges of 7.62 mm. DGP Punjab Gaurav Yadav informed on Tuesday that a major incident has been averted due to the swift and vigilant action of the Punjab Police. He said that this action was taken in view of recent inputs regarding increased Pakistan-sponsored terrorist activities and movement of gangster gangs in the border area. The DGP stated that this recovery is proof that the Punjab Police is keeping a close watch on arms smuggling from across the border.

Cold Intensifies in Delhi-NCR, Temperatures Continue to Drop: Strong Winds Improve Conditions, AQI in Orange Zone

Noida. Delhi-NCR is witnessing a significant change in weather patterns this week. Both day and night temperatures have started falling rapidly, giving people the first clear feeling of winter in November. According to the India Meteorological Department (IMD) report, the minimum night temperature may drop to 14 degrees Celsius in the coming days, while the maximum temperature will remain around 27 degrees. A continuous drop in temperature is expected in the forecast from November 5 to November 10. The week started with a minimum temperature of 16 degrees and a maximum of 29 degrees, but the minimum temperature is expected to reach 14 degrees on November 9 and 10. There will be mild sunshine during the day, but the morning and evening chill will be more pronounced. The wind speed increased in Noida, Ghaziabad, Gurugram, and Delhi after Sunday night, which has also improved the air quality. The AQI, which had been continuously in the 'very poor' category for the past three days, has now reached the 'orange zone' or 'poor' category.

Kartik Purnima Witnesses Massive Devotional Gathering in Kolhan; Thousands Take Holy Dip at Swarnrekha, Kharkai, and Karo River Ghats

Jamshedpur: On the auspicious occasion of Kartik Purnima on Wednesday, Kolhan saw an extraordinary confluence of devotion and faith. Chhota Bakau Gram Sabha Highlights Local Issues; Villagers Demand Concrete Action from Administration

Chaibasa: In Chhota Bakau village of Pandavir Panchayat, Sadar Block, West Singhbhum, villagers raised their local issues and concerns during a Gram Sabha held on Wednesday. The meeting was presided over by Munda Budhay Singh Savai and Munda Jitra Savai, with Panchayat head Motai Boypai also in attendance. Residents highlighted several pressing issues, including the poor condition of the village

road, which makes commuting difficult. They expressed dissatisfaction over the incomplete bridge construction over a hill stream, stating that survey work was conducted but construction remains stalled, disrupting connectivity with surrounding areas. Mobile network problems were also discussed, as villagers reported that despite a tower being installed, connectivity remains poor, making communication during emergencies challenging. Additionally, due to the



absence of a selected Sahiya (health worker) for the past two months, pregnant women have been deprived of essential health services. While a health sub-center building has been constructed in Peta PT village, it has not yet become operational. Social worker Ramesh Balmuchu and advocate Mahendra Jamuda attended the meeting, listening to villagers' concerns. Advocate Jamuda assured that these issues would be raised with the Deputy Commissioner, and action

would be taken to operationalize the health sub-center, complete road and bridge construction, and restore mobile network connectivity. Other notable attendees included Pradhan Tamasoy, Govind Tubid, Harish Tamasoy, and Arjun Boypai, along with numerous villagers. Suspicious Death of Married Woman in Shastrinagar, Husband Absconding, Police Investigation Underway

Jamshedpur: In Shastrinagar area under Kadma Police Station, a married woman allegedly committed suicide under suspicious circumstances on Tuesday afternoon. The deceased has been identified as Geeta Sona. At the time of the incident, only her two young children were at home, while her husband Sonu Singh was out for daily wage work. According to reports, when Sonu Singh returned home in the afternoon, he found Geeta hanging. He immediately informed her maternal relatives. After removing the body, Sonu Singh left the house stating he would call a tempo and has been missing since then. Her relatives stated that about seven years ago, Geeta had a romantic relationship with Sonu Singh, and the couple had moved to Delhi for marriage. They returned to Jamshedpur with their children around eight months ago. Geeta's mother, Krishna Bag, said that the couple had a dispute the previous night, which may have led to this tragic incident. The family suspects foul play and has demanded a thorough investigation into the husband's role. Kadma Police reached the spot after being informed and sent the body

Public issues resonated in the Gram Sabha, demanding action from the administration

At a Gram Sabha held on Wednesday in Chhota Bakau village of Pandaveer Panchayat in West Singhbhum Sadar block, villagers discussed various local issues and expressed their displeasure with the administration. Key Delhi air monitor went dark in peak farm fire week

The government model that tracks pollution sources in Delhi went quiet for four days during the first week of November — historically, some of the period when smoke from agricultural burning contributes most heavily to the capital's toxic air — and was updated only after HT asked authorities about the missing data.

The Decision Support System (DSS), which estimates how much different sources contribute to Delhi's PM 2.5 levels, last provided data on Friday. When the system finally updated late on Tuesday evening, it revealed no stubble burning contribution data for November 1 and 2.

Past data shows stubble burning's contribution to Delhi's air has historically surged above 35% during the first week of November, reaching as high as 48% on a single day in 2021. This year's readings show just 4.06% on Monday and 1.74% on

Tuesday.

Last year on November 1, farm fires accounted for 35.1% of Delhi's PM 2.5 pollution. The contribution remained at 35% till November 3 in both 2023 and 2022, according to DSS records.

The Indian Institute of Tropical Meteorology in Pune, which operates the model, and the Commission for Air Quality Management did not respond to queries on Tuesday about the data gap.

Harvesting and farm fires are likely delayed this year following widespread floods in Punjab, but burning has been rising in recent days. Punjab recorded 256 fires on Sunday while Haryana logged a season-high 23 fires the same day.

To be sure, the region appears to have mostly been spared of an air pollution crisis also due to more active weather conditions that usual.

"We have seen wind speeds remain high so far — the speed is enough for dispersion. At the same time, Diwali was earlier



than usual this year and farm fires are low, so we are not seeing the kind of emissions we usually see in early November," said Dipankar Saha, former head of CPCB's air laboratory. But he warned that if wind speeds drop again, it will eventually lead to accumulation of pollutants over time.

The DSS typically provides daily source contribution estimates along with a two-day forecast. It calculates pollution contributions from Delhi's own emissions and 19 neighbouring NCR towns, with stubble burn-

ing percentages updated later based on actual fire counts.

The system showed Delhi's transport sector contributed 19.91% to Tuesday's PM 2.5 levels, followed by emissions from Jhajjar at 6.54% and Gautam Buddha Nagar at 6.15%.

The DSS blackout is part of a broader pattern of monitoring failures this year. On Diwali night, nine of Delhi's 39 air quality monitoring stations stopped recording data entirely during critical hours between 11 p.m. and 4 a.m. —

the second-highest number of such failures since 2021.

"Transparency is important when we talk about fighting pollution," said Sunil Dahiya, founder and lead analyst at environmental think tank Envirocatalysts.

Dahiya, however, pointed to other problems with the DSS. "With an outdated emissions inventory, it seems none of the agencies and bodies which should be using this data are utilising it, which explains the semi-frequent updates in between."

The model continues to run on an outdated 2021 emissions inventory, officials have acknowledged, raising doubts about forecast accuracy. The system was operationalised on October 5 ahead of the winter pollution season — the same inventory issue that prompted CAQM to halt it last year and request improvements from IITM.

During last winter, DSS data was available from the start of October till November

29 before going dark until December 9. CAQM said at the time it would not use the system for pollution-related decisions because the emissions inventory was too old, though the model would continue sharing information.

At least three major real-time source identification studies have been halted or rendered obsolete in the past four years. In 2021, the Delhi government stopped a study by Washington University before its data was made public, citing "unsatisfactory" results. The work was reassigned to IIT Kanpur the same year, but that two-year study ended in November 2023 with the government again dissatisfied with methodologies and results. No replacement system has been established.

"It is a model which ticks a lot of boxes, but eventually, is turning out to be a waste of funds, unless our data is running on a new emissions inventory and is updated regularly," Dahiya said.

At UNESCO meet, India calls for ethical AI education access, heritage cooperation

New Delhi, Agency: India outlined its agenda on ethical artificial intelligence, digital education, and cultural heritage at the 43rd General Conference of UNESCO, where Ambassador Vishal V Sharma said the country's focus was on "education, ethics, and equity" as part of its Viksit Bharat vision for 2047.

The 43rd General Conference, being held in Uzbekistan from October 30 to November 13, is UNESCO's highest decision-making body, setting the agency's programmes and budget for 2026-2027.

Sharma, India's Permanent Delegate to UNESCO, said India is working with UNESCO on the Readiness Assessment Methodology (RAM) to map national preparedness for ethical and responsible AI, and pointed to a sequence of India-based consultations held with the ministry of electronics and information technology (MeitY) and IndiaAI Mission. The RAM initiative is designed to help countries assess strengths and gaps for deploying AI in line with UNESCO's



Recommendation on the Ethics of AI. He said India's National Quantum Mission and a \$29 billion AI sector "are expected to create over one million professionals by 2026", alongside a \$10 billion semiconductor mission aimed at building digital self-reliance.

Referring to India's education reforms, Sharma said the National Education Policy promotes online learning through platforms such as SWAYAM, DIKSHA, Bhashini, and PM eVidya, developed under the G20 and UNESCO frameworks.

Six killed after being hit by train while crossing tracks in UP's Mirzapur



New Delhi, Agency: Six passengers were killed after being hit by a train while crossing the railway tracks at Chunar Junction in Uttar Pradesh's Mirzapur district on Wednesday morning, barely a day after another major train accident in Chhattisgarh claimed 11 lives.

According to officials, the victims had just alighted from the Gomo-Prayagraj Express around 9.15 am and were attempting to cross the tracks from the wrong

side when they were struck by the Kalka Mail passing through platform number three. Follow Mirzapur train accident live updatesThe identities of the deceased, said to be devotees, are yet to be confirmed. Eyewitnesses described the scene as horrific, with bodies mutilated in the impact.Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath took cognizance of the incident and expressed condolences to the families of the deceased.

Paratrooper injured in gunfight between terrorists and security forces in J&K's Kishtwar



NEW DELHI, Agency: A paratrooper was injured and airlifted to a hospital in Jammu and Kashmir's Udhampur after a gun battle broke out between terrorists and security forces on Wednesday in the Kishtwar district.

Officials said that the encounter started after the Jammu and Kashmir Police, with help from the Indian Army, launched a joint operation in the Chhatru area based on intelligence about terrorists in the region.

The search operation began in the early morning, after which security forces came under fire, resulting in an exchange of gunfire.

The White Knight Corps posted on X, "In an intelligence-based operation, launched in coordination with the Jammu and Kashmir Police early this morning, alert troops of the White Knight Corps established contact with terrorists in the general area of Chhatru."

"The operation is in progress," the post added.

The security forces are closely monitoring terrorist movements

in the mountainous district, leading to several encounters along the border of Doda and Udhampur districts.

Notably, Kishtwar has witnessed six encounters over the past seven months as troops continue searching for Pakistan-based terrorists hiding in the hills.

On September 21, a group of terrorists clashed with forces in the Chhatru area. On September 13, two army personnel, including a junior commissioned officer, died and two others injured in an encounter in the Naidgram area of Chhatru.

Violent confrontations also happened in the Dul and Chhatru belts on August 11 and July 2, though the terrorists managed to escape.

On May 22, one soldier and two terrorists died during a clash in Chhatru. Further, on April 12, three terrorists were killed in Kishtwar, while the army prevented an infiltration attempt along the LoC in the Akhnoor sector.

Woman, her partner get 180-year jail term for assault of minor girl in Kerala

NEW DELHI, Agency:

A couple convicted for repeated sexual assault of a minor girl was sentenced with 180 years of imprisonment each by a Special Protection of Children from Sexual Offences (POCSO) court in Kerala's Manjeri on Tuesday. The accused in the case was a woman, who reportedly had eloped with her lover and her 11-year-old daughter to Malappuram. The crime is said to have taken place between 2019 and 2021.

The couple has also been fined with ₹11.75 lakh each and failure to pay the fine would lead to an added prison sentence of 20 years, according to an ANI news agency report.

the court has convicted both of the accused - 180 years of rigorous imprisonment and ₹11.75 lakh," Special

Public Prosecutor Somasundaram told the news agency.

This case was registered by Malappuram Police against the mother and her lover. Originally living in Thiruvananthapuram, the mother eloped with her lover and her 11-year-old daughter to Malappuram, where they resided in a rented cottage. There, with the aid and help of the mother, her lover sexually assaulted the little girl for two years, from 2019- 2021. He not only raped her, but also forced her into oral sex," Somasundaram said.

The verdict was given by Special POCSO Court Judge Ashraf AM under various sections of the Indian Penal Code (IPC), the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences (POCSO) Act, and the Juvenile Justice Act (JJ



Act). The prosecution said the girl's stepfather intimidated her by claiming a hidden camera had been implanted in her head and that any attempt to reveal the abuse would be detected. She was also given alcohol before being assaulted.

According to the prosecution, the first accused, from Palakkad, repeatedly assaulted the child between 2019 and 2021 at rented houses in Anamangad and Vallikappatta.

The second accused, the

girl's mother from Thiruvananthapuram, is accused of aiding, abetting and encouraging the abuse.

The abuse began after the woman left her husband and started living with her partner in 2019. The two accused also committed sexual intercourse in the presence of the girl. They committed offences as per the POCSO Act, as well as the Juvenile Justice Act. The Court has now convicted both the accused to 180 years of rigorous imprisonment as well as ₹11.75 lakh as fine," the Prosecutor said. If the accused submits the amount before the Court, it will be given to the minor child... They have been sent to 180 years of rigorous imprisonment, but they have to remain in jail for 40 years," Prosecutor added.

Four militants killed, one arrested in Churachandpur gunfight

Manipur, Agency: In an early morning operation on Tuesday, security forces killed at least four insurgents of banned Kuki outfit United Kuki National Army (UKNA) killed and arrested one in Manipur's Churachandpur district.

An Assam Rifles spokesperson confirmed that the incident occurred at around 6 am while conducting an intelligence based operation in Khanpi village, Churachandpur, Henglep sub-division which is approximately 80 km west of Churachandpur town. The 21 Para SF were also part of the operation.

Officials in security forces said that the militant group resorted to unprovoked firing on the security forces, and added that forces were searching adjoining areas for more insurgents.

In a statement, UKNA condemned the action of the security forces; some Kuki Zo civil society organisations also expressed condemnation of the incident.

The security officials cited above said the operation came in the week of recent incidents involving UKNA insurgents, including the killing of a village chief, intimidation of locals and attempts to disrupt peace and stability

in the region.

Successful neutralisation of these terrorists highlights the Indian Army and Assam Rifles commitment to protecting innocent civilians, mitigating all threats and ensuring peace and security in Manipur", the Assam Rifles spokesperson said in a press note.

Other security officials said that during the gunfight, at least three Assam Rifles personnel also sustained injuries.

The bodies of the insurgents have been moved to Churachandpur district hospital.

Women's Cricket Team Achieves World Victory, But Equality with Men Still Lags Behind

The Indian women's cricket team has filled the entire country with pride by winning the World Cup. This historic achievement has proven to be a significant turning point not only on the playing field but also in the direction of social change. This victory has given Indian women players a new identity, increasing both expectations and responsibilities for them. Women's cricket has come a long way in the last two decades, but inequalities still persist in many areas compared to male cricketers. In the past, the situation of women cricketers was extremely difficult. Until the 1980s, players did not receive match fees. They traveled on concession tickets on trains, stayed in ordinary accommodations, and the quality of the kits they received was also very poor. At that time, women's cricket was run by the "Women's Cricket Association of India," but in 2006, it merged with the Board of Control for Cricket in India (BCCI). After this, improvements in women's cricket began, and today it has established a strong identity at the international level.

In October 2022, the BCCI took a historic decision that women and men players would now be paid equal match fees. That is, both receive equal payment of 15 lakhs for Test matches, 6 lakhs for ODIs, and 3 lakhs for T20s. However, there is still a big difference in the annual contract amounts. Male cricketers receive 7 crores, 5 crores, 3 crores, and 1 crore annually in A+, A, B, and C grades respectively, while the three grades for women players, A, B, and C, are fixed at 50 lakhs, 30 lakhs, and 10 lakhs respectively. The same structure has been implemented in domestic cricket as well, but some differences are still seen in state associations. While male players' salaries in the IPL are in crores, the income of women cricketers in the Women's Premier League (WPL) is limited to 10 lakhs to 3.4 crores. This difference still reflects inequality in the economic aspect of the sport. In terms of facilities, male players also have an advantage. They regularly receive access to better nets, state-of-the-art training, rehabilitation centers, and expert physiotherapists. The number of support staff for women players is still limited. However, there has been improvement in recent years, with the women's team now receiving business class travel and accommodation in five-star hotels, which was previously limited only to the men's team. Male cricketers also have an advantage in terms of medical and recovery facilities. While women players receive equal facilities during major tournaments, this level is not consistently maintained. There is also an inequality in mental health support. Male players have permanent access to mental coaches and counselors, while this facility is still in its nascent stages for the women's team. In terms of brand value and sponsorships, male players continue to dominate. Male players have a significantly larger share in BCCI's media rights and individual endorsement deals. Women players have had limited opportunities so far, although this scenario may gradually change after the launch of the WPL and the World Cup win. Inequality in funding levels still persists. In 2023-24, the BCCI's total budget was approximately 12,000 crore, with less than 1 percent spent on the development of women's cricket. This disparity clearly indicates that women's cricket requires more institutional support. This victory of the Indian women's team is not just a success in one tournament, but a strong call for change. It has shown that with equal opportunities and resources, Indian women players are second to none in world cricket.

The World Needs Dattopant Thengadi's Indian Economic Perspective

Dattopant Thengadi was born on November 10, 1920, in Arvi village of Wardha district in Maharashtra. He completed his LLB from Nagpur Law College and his postgraduate studies from Morris College. In 1940, when M.S. Golwalkar Guruji was appointed the second Sarsanghchalak of the RSS, he encouraged young people to dedicate themselves to full-time service as RSS Pracharaks to expand the organization's reach. Responding to this invitation, Thengadi ji became an RSS Pracharak in 1942 and remained so until his death at the age of 84 on October 14, 2004. He had no desire for official positions. It was for this reason that he declined the offer of the Padma Bhushan award from the NDA government. Thengadi ji was often called the "silent strategist." He was a visionary architect rather than an overly reactive speaker. He believed that strong institutions, discipline, and clear thinking were essential for long-term change.

Instead of controlling leadership, he worked in the background to nurture it. Those who knew him remember his humility, his unwavering faith in nationalist ideals, and his understanding of philosophy, economics, and history. His work demonstrates a unique blend of cultural connections and economic pragmatism. He was influenced by the global philosophy of Integral Humanism propagated by Deendayal Upadhyaya and India's civilizational ethos.

Global Economic Issues vs. Hindu Economic System

Globalization, which has exacerbated inequality

and human rights violations globally, was a creation of the Western world. The rich are getting richer, and the poor are getting poorer. Most of the world's wealth is held by 1% of the people. According to the OXFAM report presented at the Davos Economic Forum, the wealth of the eight richest people in the world is equal to that of the poorest half of the world's population, i.e., 4 billion people. Furthermore, hunger claims the lives of 8 million people every year, while both curable and incurable diseases also claim a similar number of lives.

Dattopant Thengadi expressed serious concern about the possibility of developed nations exploiting smaller countries. He stated, "Some developed countries (or their ideological leaders) do not want to cooperate in efforts to maintain ecological balance, but rather spread their pollution in the backyard of developing countries." However, this approach will not prevent a global environmental catastrophe for very long, and Western nations will not be spared either. The calamity will ultimately destroy prosperity everywhere because there is only one world. Economic conditions serve as the base, but various superstructural elements—the political and legal forms of class struggles and their consequences, the constitution and legal forms—as well as the reflections of these real struggles in the minds of the participants—political-legal, philosophical theories, and their religious beliefs—all influence the development of historical struggles and, in many cases, determine their form.

In his book, Global

Economic System: The Hindu View, Thengadiji argued that "it is imperative to abandon the current version of Eurocentric history, which lacks a sense of proportion, and to initiate a new phase of historical inquiry, a new framework, new contexts, and a new scale of values that will facilitate globalization." Additionally, he emphasized that the Hindu concept of Dharma could provide the best framework for creating an economy that prioritizes the ideal of social well-being rather than the relentless, competitive pursuit of material wealth.

The principles outlined in Hindu religious texts such as the Shastras and Smritis serve as the foundation of Thengadi's Hindu economic system.

Contrary to the "wage-employment" promoted by Western economic ideology, he described the Hindu model of progress and development as having "self-employment" as one of its key features. Such a large number of people entering the workforce cannot be employed by the government. Unlike the "ever-growing army of the proletariat" characteristic of Western economic strategy, the aim is to establish an "ever-growing self-employment sector."The Hindu economic philosophy promotes "free competition in an unmanipulated market where nature is utilized, not exploited" and "moves towards equity and equality." It encourages "complete harmony between the individual, society, and nature." The Western approach, however, results in "continuous conflict between the individual, society, and nature" and "ever-increasing inequalities in society."

According to our traditions, society functions best when all parties fulfill their


responsibilities with a sense of mutual respect and shared accountability. The concept of "co-working" reflects this. Employees are not instruments of production in the economic process, but co-creators. The ancient Indian concepts of "respect for labor" and "public welfare" are consistent with the idea that employees should actively participate in management and profit-sharing.

Why Self-Reliance is Necessary

According to Thengadi ji, the founder of Swadeshi economics, Swadeshi is about much more than just products and services. It is about the determination to achieve national self-reliance, maintain national independence and sovereignty, and engage in equitable international cooperation. "Swadeshi is the practical, external expression of patriotic sentiments. Separatist thinking is not the same as the feeling of nationalism. Patriots do not oppose globalization. As long as international cooperation is considered equitable, their argument for national self-reliance is not inconsistent with it. He said that unemployment should be tackled on a war footing.

One of his works, "The Third Way," laid the foundation of "Swadeshi" economics. The only alternative to replace capitalism and communism is an economy and society based on the principles of Dharma and the Hindu approach to life. In his ideal society and economy, self-employment, free competition, equality, and complete harmony between the individual, the community, and the natural world will all flourish.

Every culture has its own model. A development model imposed by foreign vested



interests or imported from another cultural context can be harmful. Ivan Illich is the renowned author of "Towards a History of Needs." His Mexican experience with the myth of development is described in "Medical Nemesis," "Tools for Conviviality and Deschooling Society." He analyzes the effects of development on the lives of the poor living in rural areas and slums, the erosion of traditional skills and means of livelihood, the decline of community self-reliance, dignity, and solidarity, the destruction of nature, displacement from traditional environments, unemployment, the destruction of nature, displacement from traditional self-sufficient communities into a cash economy, cultural

rootlessness, and political corruption.

Although religion and Dharma are not the same, the world must recognize the power of Dharma, not religion, which is considered an opiate in communist analysis. Thengadi ji advanced Hindu economic thought by deeply studying the intellectual foundations of "Dharma," moving beyond the concepts of capitalism and communism. Thus, understanding the true philosophical significance of Prime Minister Narendra Modi's call for "Atmanirbhar Bharat" (Self-Reliant India) and combating this global crisis and its negative effects is only possible by understanding Thengadi ji's perspective.

Nitish Kumar - Messiah of the Poor of Bihar

Today, very few people know about the next Chief Minister of Bihar, but according to my prediction, Nitish Kumar is most likely to become the next Chief Minister of Bihar, either with the support of the NDA or other parties. Because he knows what to do and when, and a large community in Bihar is supporting him, mostly women. Nitish Kumar is the longest-serving Chief Minister of Bihar, and this is also his ninth term. He is the leader of the Janata Dal (United). Earlier, Nitish had also served as a Union Minister as a member of the Samata Party. He was a member of the Samata Party until 2005 and of the Janata Dal from 1989 to 1994. Nitish first entered politics as a member of the Janata Dal and became an MLA in 1985. A socialist, Nitish, along with George Fernandes, founded the Samata Party in 1994. In 1996, he

was elected to the Lok Sabha and served as a Union Minister in Atal Bihari Vajpayee's government. His party joined the National Democratic Alliance. In 2003, his party merged with the Janata Dal (United), and Nitish became its leader. In 2005, the NDA secured a majority in the Bihar Assembly, and Nitish became Chief Minister, leading a coalition with the Bharatiya Janata Party. In the 2010 state elections, the ruling coalition achieved a landslide victory. In June 2013, after Narendra Modi was made the Prime Ministerial candidate, Nitish broke ties with the BJP and formed a Grand Alliance with the Rashtriya Janata Dal and the Indian National Congress and joined the United Progressive Alliance. After the party suffered a crushing defeat in the 2014 general elections, Nitish resigned as Chief Minister on May 17, 2014, and was replaced by Jitan Ram Manjhi. However, he attempted a comeback

as Chief Minister in February 2015, which led to a political crisis, and ultimately Manjhi had to resign, and Kumar became Chief Minister again. Later that year, the Grand Alliance won a landslide victory in the state elections. In 2017, facing corruption allegations, Nitish broke ties with the RJD and returned to the NDA, leading another coalition with the BJP; his government was re-elected by a narrow margin in the 2020 state elections. In August 2022, Nitish left the NDA and rejoined the Grand Alliance (Mahagathbandhan) and the UPA. In January 2024, Nitish once again left the Grand Alliance and rejoined the NDA. Nitish comes from the socialist school of politics. In his early years as a politician, he was associated with Ram Manohar Lohia, S. N. Sinha, Karpoori Thakur, and V. P. Singh. Nitish participated in Jayaprakash Narayan's movement between 1974 and 1977 and joined the Janata Party led by Satyendra

Narayan Sinha. Unlike Lalu Prasad Yadav, who is considered a populist, Nitish is considered a skilled communicator. Nitish contested and won his first state assembly election from Harnaut in 1985. In the early years, Nitish supported Lalu Prasad Yadav as the Leader of the Opposition in the Bihar Assembly in 1989, but later, after winning his first Lok Sabha seat from Barh in 1996, Nitish joined the BJP. The Janata Dal had previously survived a split when leaders like Nitish and George Fernandes defected to form the Samata Party in 1994, but it remained a rudderless party after Lalu Prasad's decision to form the Rashtriya Janata Dal in 1997. The second split occurred before Rabri Devi came to power, resulting in only two significant leaders remaining in the Janata Dal, namely Sharad Yadav and Ram Vilas Paswan. Paswan was considered an emerging leader of the Dalits and was credited with winning

elections by unprecedented margins. His popularity reached the national level when he was given the post of Railway Minister in the United Front government in 1996 and later made the Leader of the House in the Lok Sabha. Their influence was also seen in western Uttar Pradesh, when their followers organized an impressive rally at the call of a new organization called the Dalit Panthers. In the 1999 Lok Sabha elections, the Rashtriya Janata Dal suffered a crushing defeat at the hands of the BJP+JD(U) alliance. The new alliance was leading in 199 out of 324 assembly constituencies, and it was widely believed that the Lalu-Rabri rule would come to an end in the upcoming Bihar assembly elections. The RJD contested the elections in alliance with the Congress, but this alliance did not work, and the Congress state leadership became convinced that Lalu Prasad's tarnished image after being implicated in the fodder scam

had diminished his support base. As a result, the Congress decided to contest the 2000 assembly elections alone.

The RJD had to be content with the Communist parties as alliance partners, but due to complications in seat-sharing within the National Democratic Alliance (NDA), Nitish Kumar separated his Samata Party from the Sharad Yadav and Ram Vilas Paswan factions of the Janata Dal. Differences also arose between the BJP and Nitish Kumar as Nitish Kumar wanted to project himself as the Chief Minister of Bihar, but Nitish Kumar... The RJD emerged as the largest party, and thanks to Lalu Yadav's political maneuvering, Rabri Devi was sworn in as Chief Minister again. The media largely failed to grasp the ground-level polarization in Bihar. Sharad Yadav was also a senior socialist leader, but he lacked a broad popular base. In the 1998 parliamentary elections, the Samata

Party and the Janata Dal, which were significantly weakened after the formation of the RJD, began to encroach on each other's vote banks. This led Nitish to merge the two parties, forming the Janata Dal (United). There is no doubt that the upper-caste media has always been anti-Lalu and either lacked knowledge of the ground-level polarization in Bihar or deliberately ignored it. If the election results were not a crushing blow for the RJD, it was mainly due to the bleak picture painted by the media. Against this backdrop, the RJD's defeat seemed like a victory. Even after serving a jail sentence in connection with the 1997 scam, Lalu seemed to relish his role as the lower-caste jester. He argued that the corruption charges against him and his family were a conspiracy by the upper-caste bureaucracy and media elite, who were fearful of the rise of the peasant farming castes.

Who will take the reins of power in Bihar?

After defeats in every state, the Congress and the Grand Alliance should now accept that this is not the time for them to rule, either at the center or in the states. Given the rise of nationalism worldwide, this is the time for the Bharatiya Janata Party, which came to power riding on the chariot of the Rashtriya Swayamsevak Sangh, with Narendra Modi and Amit Shah as its charioteers. This Indian society, connected by mobile phones and the internet, is not easily misled. Rahul cannot deceive an educated society. Rahul Gandhi, who targeted Modi,

Donald Trump, Adani, and Ambani in the Bihar elections, seems unaware of what should and shouldn't be said regarding foreign policy. Because Indian foreign policy is currently at its best. External Affairs Minister S. Jaishankar's policies have been appreciated by all countries in the world today. A lack of political and practical knowledge leads to difficulties in governing the country. Leaders who have taken India to great heights understand everything. Rahul, who talks about Nalanda University, should know that the Congress party is responsible for the state of this heritage site. The BJP has been in power for only ten years, but the Congress ruled for 60 years. The plight of the backward classes is the doing of the Congress. 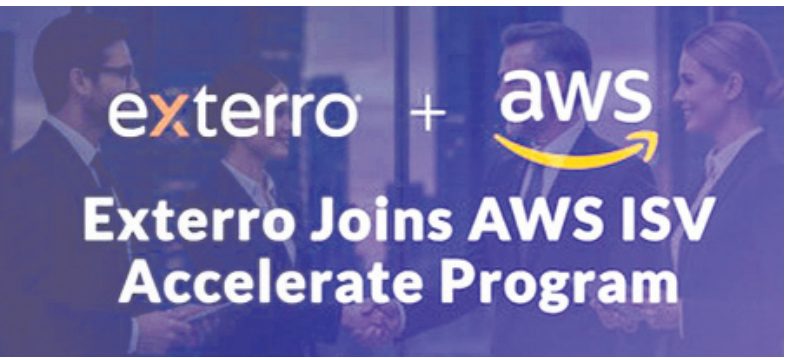

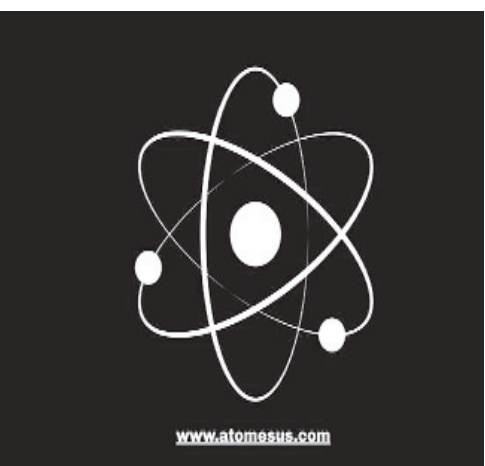

Team India is testing different combinations ahead of the T20 World Cup, Morne Morkel

Hobart: Indian fast bowler Arshdeep Singh bowled brilliantly in the third T20 International against Australia on Sunday, taking three wickets and earning the Player of the Match award. However, Arshdeep has only had the opportunity to play three T20 Internationals since the five-match T20 series against England. He has taken the most wickets for us in the powerplay, so we know how valuable he is to the team. But our aim on this tour is to test other



options as well, and he understands that." Regarding team selection, Morkel said that choosing from such a large player pool is not easy, and some players may face disappointment. Morkel said the team is working on various options to be prepared for any situation before the World Cup. He said, "There will be disappointment regarding selection, but everything is not always in a player's control. Our message

is to work hard and when the opportunity arises, come fully prepared. There are limited matches left before the World Cup, so it is important to see how the players react under pressure." He said, "Every team is currently working on its combination. We know certain combinations, but flexibility is essential in T20 cricket. You want to know which player can perform better in which role. In a tournament like the World Cup, no possibility should be left unexplored." Morkel also provided an update on Nitish Kumar Reddy's fitness. Reddy was ruled out of the first three T20 matches due to a neck strain and a quadriceps injury. He said, "Nitish completed all the necessary drills today, including fielding, batting, and bowling. Now, after an examination by his medical team, it will be known whether he is fit for the next match or not." The T20 series between India and Australia is now in its decisive phase, and the team management is seriously strategizing about its final combination before the World Cup.

playing in the fourth round of the Sheffield Shield. Cameron Green is returning to bowling, which will provide us with more information." Mitchell Marsh has been left out of the squad despite his impressive performances in white-ball cricket, despite recent support from coach and selector Andrew McDonald. Steve Smith will assume captaincy duties in the first Test due to Pat Cummins'

back injury. The match will be played in Perth from November 21.
